



Three years of treatments and hospital stays, setbacks and progress, bad news and good. After a hard-fought battle with multiple myeloma that included a successful stem cell transplant, the well-respected builder got the news that things were looking up and he knew he was going to make some major life changes.

They sold their 25-acre country property and purchased two lots backing onto the Belle River. Their ducks in a row, so to speak, the family then concentrated on getting John well enough to walk Jillian down the aisle in October 2015. With the determination and strength of character he's well known for, he did just that, albeit in a back brace. "It was great motivation," John says. "There was no way I was going to miss one of the biggest moments in my daughter's life."

"Cancer has a way of putting everything in perspective," agrees Karen. "And when in Christmas 2015, Jillian and Ryan gave us an empty picture frame and told us our present wouldn't be arriving until June, we knew we had another milestone to look forward to."

That present arrived right on schedule when the couple's first grandchild, Charlotte, made her debut in June 2016. It's clear she has a special bond with her Papa. The minute she toddles into the house she heads straight for her grandfather and demands to be picked up. They cuddle into the sofa with a book, oblivious to the activity around them. "There's nothing better than this," John says, smiling over Charlotte's head. "Nothing at all."

Their new home has allowed the couple the freedom to relax and enjoy being with their children and grandchild. Working with Jodi Mason of Urban Home Furniture & Design **Studio** made the transition from their former home as seamless as possible. "With everything that was going on with John I knew I wouldn't have time to get our new place furnished," Karen says. "I wanted all new furniture because our old home was a completely different style. I absolutely love everything Jodi did. I couldn't have done it without her and I can't praise her









enough. Everyone who comes here says 'Oh my goodness!' They can't believe how lovely it is."

The easy-maintenance furnishings and finishes allow the couple more time to relax and enjoy each other's company. "I chose a trans-contemporary style for the home," Mason says of her design ideas. "They wanted it to be elegant yet warm and casual."

The porcelain high-gloss tiles and hand-scraped floors (Hi! Neighbor Floor **Covering Company**) in a matte finish make cleaning easy-peasy says Mason. "I kept the furnishings neutral, yet big and comfy." "We wanted to see the light," Karen adds.

"Our old home was a lot darker and coming here to the water was a fantastic change. Light and airy was what I wanted. At first I was skeptical about the blue accents," she continues. "But being on the water it turned out to be the perfect choice."

The barn board accent wall adds an earthy natural feel that grounds the room and gives it an appealing rustic element. "The wall with the fireplace (Fireplaces by Mario Inc.) has a big presence in the room," Mason concludes, "and so it was important how we dressed it. The sleek, white kitchen (Windmill **Cabinet Shop Ltd.**) with its expansive granite island (**Universal Marble & Granite**) is the perfect place for the family to gather, as is the outdoor recreation area complete with lanai (**Seaton Sunrooms**) and the pool (The Great Outdoors) that John used as a key part of his rehabilitation right up until mid-November. "With the back operations and spinal fusion surgeries, I was unable to walk," John says. "I went from a wheelchair to a walker to a cane in two-anda-half years. 


